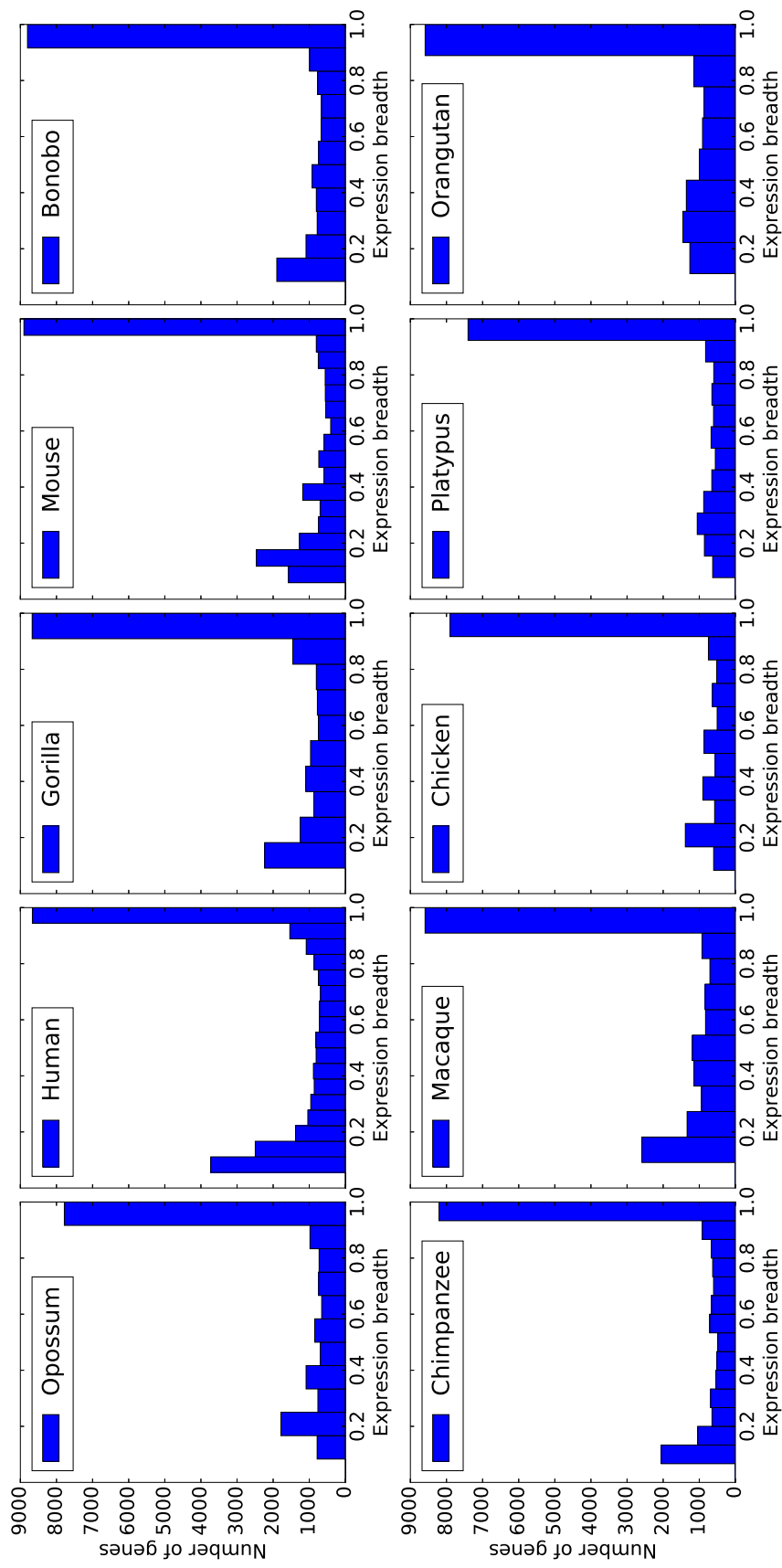


Figure 1: **Supplementary Figure 1. Gene usage distribution across mammalian and chicken organs.** In [1], the authors have compiled gene expression levels for different organs in different mammalian species and chicken. Counting the number of organs in which every gene is expressed reveals a very large number of constitutive genes, and, in most cases, a slightly large number of specific genes.
